ACTIVITIES

- Recruit and train community volunteers to be Court Appointed Special Advocates
- appoint volunteers to juvenile court opened cases
- provide advocacy to children in substitute care
- hold all parties accountable to obligations in the case plan
- present recommendation semi-annually and at reviews
- conduct monthly child-contact, home visits and quarterly case reviews with ongoing caseworkers
- stay up to date on CASA certification credentials
- maintain monthly supervision with CASA staff
- provide in-service training opportunities
- establish and maintain an advisory board

OUTPUTS

- signed memorandum with the courts in March 2019 initiating program
- recognized by National CASA as a official CASA program in 2019
- hired first Director in February 2020
- recruited 20 + casa volunteers in year one
- Scheduled first training of CASA volunteers in July 2020

OUTCOMES

Short-term

- achieve immediate child safety
- build rapport with child
- provide families necessary services to achieve goals
- train new CASA volunteers

Intermediate

- create and maintain an advisory/fundraising board
- increase rates of reunification
- hire volunteer managers
- build resiliency in children

Long-term

- parents achieve stability and resolve safety concerns
- family is reunified
- child achieves permanency
- child receives a consistent advocate throughout the case
- serve 75% of children in care
